Butt Kapinski invited 2013 Fringe Festival audiences to co-star in a film noir fantasy. Vancouver was struck with the shadows, sin, sex, and violence in the reality bending experience. The show won the Volunteer Choice Award and the Cultivating the Fringe Award that year, and since then has taken home Best of the Fest Awards at the Hollywood, Edmonton, and Calgary Fringes, Patron's Pick at the Orlando Fringe, and most recently, Best Comedy at the 2016 Adelaide Fringe.
